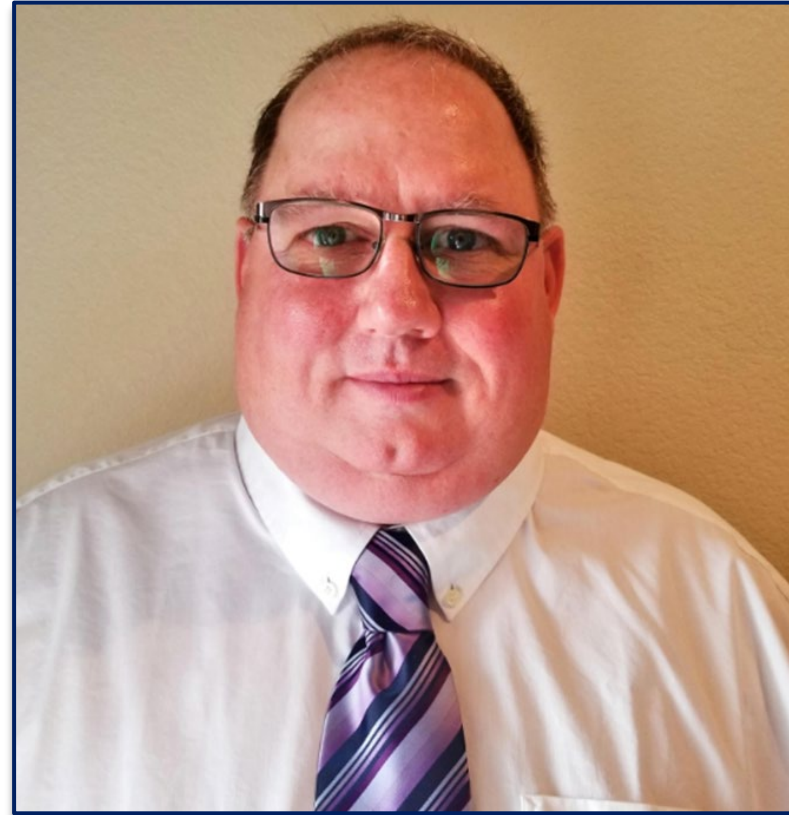

- ▶ **CMBL is part of the Statewide Procurement Division (SPD), under the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts (CPA)**
- ▶ **SPD is the central authority for state procurement in Texas**
- ▶ **The Centralized Master Bidders List (CMBL) is a master database used by the State of Texas purchasers to develop a mailing list for vendors to receive bid opportunities based on the products or services the state is procuring.**





The Registration Fee

There is a cost of registering for the CMBL of 70.00 Dollars per year. It begins the date of payment and the registration expires on the anniversary of that date. The registration payment helps to cover the costs of the CMBL and HUB programs

CENTRALIZED MASTER BIDDERS LIST (CMBL)

Manufacturers, suppliers, and other vendors wishing to furnish materials, equipment, supplies, and services to the state should register for the Centralized Master Bidders List (CMBL) to receive bidding opportunities.

CMBL is a master database used by the state of Texas purchasing entities to develop a mailing list of vendors to receive bids based on the products or services they can provide to the state of Texas.

CMBL annual registration fee is \$70 and may be paid on-line by credit/debit card or check debit card (credit card addresses only) or via a [printable application](#) (PDF).

Vendors can [manage and update their CMB business profile](#), as well as [submit their CMBL annual registration fee](#) in the online vendor registration system.

Comptroller of Public Accounts (CPA) Bid Notification

Centralized Master Bidders List - HUB Directory Search

The **CMBL** is a master database used by State of Texas purchasing entities to develop a mailing list for vendors to receive bids based on the products or services they can provide to the State of Texas. Manufacturers, suppliers, and other vendors wishing to furnish materials, equipment, supplies, and services to the state should register for the CMBL to receive bidding opportunities.

The CMBL/HUB Directory Search is automatically defaulted to "CMBL Only" to perform a search for vendors, including [Texas certified HUBs](#) who have elected to [register on the CMBL](#). Purchasing entities use [NIGP Class and Item Codes](#) within the "Multiple Vendor Search" feature to identify vendors who can provide the products or services they want to purchase, and to develop mailing lists of vendors to receive bids.

Please note bid posting requirements

- **Procurement Opportunities up to \$5,000:** Competitive bids are not required but purchasing from state of Texas certified HUBs is encouraged. In such instances agencies will frequently refer to vendors registered (active) on the CMBL with the NIGP Class/Item *Note: Universities thresholds are slightly different from state agency thresholds.
- **Procurement Opportunities of \$5,000 to \$25,000:** State agencies are required to solicit a minimum of three vendors registered (active) on the CMBL two of the three vendors solicited through this process are required to be state of Texas certified HUBs
- **Procurement Opportunities over \$25,000:** State agencies are required to send notice of the procurement opportunity to all the vendors registered (active) on the CMBL
- ❖ Bid must match the [NIGP Class/Item Codes](#) applicable to the products and/or services being procured by the agency and are relevant to the [Texas Highway District\(s\)](#) where vendors can provide their products or services.
